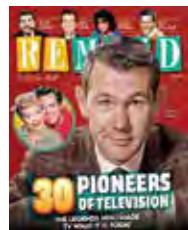

## RANDOM RANTS, RAVES & THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

### ■ TCM Gives Marilyn Monroe Star Of The Month Treatment

On the 100th anniversary of Norma Jeane's birth — and more than six decades after her death — the complex and enigmatic Marilyn Monroe remains etched in the global consciousness. TCM honors the star by showcasing her films every Monday beginning June 1 with 1953's *Gentlemen Prefer Blondes*, where Monroe's indelible, career-defining performance of "Diamonds Are a Girl's Best Friend" cemented her as a superstar. Also part of the "Star of the Month" kickoff lineup are 1953's *How to Succeed in Business Without Really Trying*, 1952's *Monkey Business* and 1948's *Ladies of the Chorus*, which features Monroe's first onscreen singing performance. Later this month look for favorites like *The Asphalt Jungle* (June 8), *The Seven Year Itch* (June 15), *Some Like It Hot* (June 22) and more!

### ■ "Dancing With the Stars" Announces Two Cast Members & Spinoff

While Season 35 of *Dancing With the Stars* won't premiere for several months, fans got a nice tease when ABC announced the official renewal, including two of the stars who will be hitting the ballroom. Season 34 featured the return of Tom Bergeron as a guest judge, and he urged ABC to "bring back the results show" in 2026 because "the show is setting ratings records again." (*Dancing With the Stars* used to air two nights a week, with voting lines open overnight, as opposed to one night where voting happens in real time throughout the episode, which is the current format.) Whether the network will take Bergeron's advice remains to be seen. The first two cast members who were announced are Bravo's *Summer House* star Ciara

Miller and *The Traitors/Love Island* alum Maura Higgins. Next month, ABC will also introduce a spinoff series titled *Dancing With the Stars: The Next Pro*, where Robert Irwin will host, but more on that in the July issue.



### ■ "The White Lotus" Heads To France

While it's still unknown if any of the *Survivor 50* castaways will appear on writer Mike White's next season of *The White Lotus*, we do know that White

is filming along the French Riviera for Season 4 of the popular HBO series. Some notable members confirmed for the new season include Helena Bonham Carter, Vincent Cassel, Alexander Ludwig, Chris Messina, Chloe Bennet, Sandra Bernhard and Heather Graham.

### ■ Will "The Bachelor" Return For 2027?

Following the shake-up surrounding the abrupt cancellation of the Taylor Frankie Paul season of *The Bachelorette* in March and the departure of two top showrunners, questions have been coming in about the status of the landmark series *The Bachelor*. ABC has shared that *The Bachelor* Season 30 will return in 2027. Disney exec Rob Mills said, "I do think better days are ahead for the franchise."

It's rare to find a series that is so feel-good enriching and delightfully entertaining as Nat Geo's four-episode docuseries *Best of the World With Antoni Porowski*, and credit goes to the charming Polish Canadian (now proud New Yorker) host. For 10 seasons, Porowski offered his food and wine expertise on *Queer Eye* but has now found a new sweet spot uncovering some of the world's most extraordinary travel destinations and its people.

"This is the bucket list dream that I never really thought I had," Porowski tells us, getting emotional just thinking about it. "I'm a lucky, lucky boy, and I'm extremely grateful. My joke with *No Taste Like Home* was that I basically got Nat Geo to fund my world travels. And with *Best of the World*, it's like we get to do all these things."

His travels take him to Mexico City, Paris, London and New York City, where sharing the world's best includes the unexpected — Swimming in London? The world's largest lily pads in Paris? New York's Governors Island's glamping and spa? Guava rolls in Mexico City ("The best foods are always messy!")? — as well as a mix of luxurious and opulent must-sees, historical mindblowers and poetic eats that could bring him to tears.

"We're going to go to amazing places. It's Nat Geo. These guys know how to knock it out of the park visually and make something that's really compelling, entertaining, educational and informative," Porowski adds, but his focus was to get real, passionate individuals who are keeping these traditions and treasures alive. "I want people who are complete and utter nerds at one specific thing." Mission accomplished, Antoni. Bring on another serving! — *Barb Oates*

NBC takes viewers back 450 million years in this landmark, eight-episode nature documentary series. Each episode uses cutting-edge digital technology to bring to life the amazing creatures and breathtaking landscapes of a vibrant, lost world. Earth's evolution is one of catastrophic events — meteor strikes, volcanic eruptions, plunging sea levels, scorching heat storms and cataclysmic climate change — resulting in mass extinctions and the emergence of new species. From the creators of *Walking With Dinosaurs*, these are the stories of the survivors, fighters and lucky animals that shaped the world we live in. *Surviving Earth* is followed by encores of last year's *The Americas* documentary series narrated by Tom Hanks.

**SEASON PREMIERE!**

A deadly showdown is coming — and early — between queens Rhaenyra (Emma D'Arcy) and Alicent (Olivia Cooke). Season 2 ended with Rhaenyra surrounded by scrolls containing decades of Targaryen history, and Alicent looking out on the horizon at Dragonstone surrounded by the open air — signaling the power has shifted to Rhaenyra. While Alicent begged Rhaenyra, in their last secret meeting, to come with her, Rhaenyra's call to duty was far too great — ultimately leaving Alicent without the person she truly wants with her most. The eight-episode Season 3 sees Aemond (Ewan Mitchell) with a terrorizing blue eyeball in place of that eye patch, and Daemon (Matt Smith) telling Rhaenyra, "You will have an empire unassailable. And our children will rule it forever and a day." As the trailer teased, "We will all become beasts before our end ... and there will be no doubt who the gods have chosen to rule." Season 4 has already been confirmed.

It's *Candid Camera*, home-renovation style! New Kids on the Block singer and now restoration expert Jonathan Knight hosts this high-adrenaline series that finds unsuspecting homeowners getting ambushed with a free, 72-hour renovation of a lackluster space of their choosing. The series is a reboot of sorts of the *Crashers* franchise. With ambushes happening anywhere from furniture boutiques to the hardware store or even the local paint shop, Knight offers folks a fast-paced reno with a catch. Before the work begins, the homeowners must agree to three rules: The renovation starts immediately; they have no say in the design; and they must vacate their home for the full three days.

### 5 LIFE, LARRY AND THE PURSUIT OF UNHAPPINESS: AN ALMOST HISTORY OF AMERICA

Fridays beginning June 26 on HBO  
**LIMITED SERIES!**

Larry David is back to his familiar social faux pas shtick, and this time has joined forces with the Obamas and plenty of Hollywood A-listers in honoring America's 250th anniversary in the most unusual of ways. In one of the sketches of the seven-episode limited series, we see David playing an elderly man on V-J Day (when victory over Japan was declared, ending World War II) who grabs a random nurse on the street and tries kissing her. Things get uncomfortable quickly when the nurse calls him a perv and her boyfriend — a U.S. sailor — arrives on the scene. The series is directed by *Curb Your Enthusiasm* and *Seinfeld* alum Jeff Schaffer and features a rotating cast of familiars including Jeff Garlin, J.B. Smoove and Susie Essman, along with guest stars like Bill Hader and Kathryn Hahn (as Abe and Mary Todd Lincoln), Jon Hamm and Sean Hayes (as the Wright brothers), and Jerry Seinfeld (as William Clark to David's Meriwether Lewis). Vince Vaughn, Lin-Manuel Miranda and former President Barack Obama will also appear.



## 6 HISTORY'S GREATEST MACHINES WITH DOLPH LUNDGREN

Mondays beginning June 1 on HISTORY  
**NEW SERIES!**

Before he became an action star playing *Rocky IV*'s reviled Soviet boxer Ivan Drago, Dolph Lundgren left his native Sweden and traveled the world to study chemical engineering. He grew up in a family of engineers, and his brother owned a petrochemical company. "He's living a different life," Lundgren says of his sibling. "He certainly doesn't get punched by Sly Stallone or drive armored vehicles with .50 caliber machine guns on them. So I think I lucked out. I think I had a very interesting life this way."

Lundgren brings his passions for science and storytelling together as executive producer, host and narrator of *History's Greatest Machines With Dolph Lundgren*, an eight-part series exploring the biggest, fastest, most powerful and most complex inventions that changed the course of world events.

While the printing press, the steam engine, the Ford Model T and the transistor would help to build modern society, many of the most significant devices created by humans came from conflict, where humanity's darker impulses often sparked its brightest innovations.

"I'm interested in rocket technology because of the way it came out of World War II, and came out of wartime use from the German side," Lundgren says. "World War II turned into the Cold War, and these guys were brought over from Germany and developed the Saturn V rocket, which then became the Apollo missions."

That tension between destruction and progress runs throughout human history with machines, from the atomic bomb to the nuclear reactor. "It can be turned into something positive, which is great that at least things can be used to help humanity," Lundgren says. — *Ryan A. Berenz*



## 7 MILLION DOLLAR NANNIES

If you thought *The Secret Lives of Mormon Wives* was fascinating, get ready for the next exposé of sorts as the untold secrets of nannies to the rich and famous are about to be explored. This eight-episode series, which drops in its entirety June 18 on Hulu, follows a young group of elite nannies (and mannies) — many being TikTok and social media content creators — who head to Ibiza to launch a new kind of agency, built by nannies, for nannies. They're promised VIP families, life-changing money and a shot at something bigger than any of them could build alone; the press materials share, however, that fierce competition, drama and a scandal threaten to derail that dream.

## 8 THE VAMPIRE LESTAT

Sundays beginning June 7 on AMC  
**SEASON PREMIERE!**

Although a blood oath prohibits me from revealing what I saw on the Toronto set of AMC's renamed *Interview With the Vampire*, it's safe to say that this is the same show fans die over (sexy, scary, sharply written) and a helluva lot has changed for our beloved bloodsuckers. First up is obviously the title: The critically acclaimed crown jewel of Anne Rice's Immortal Universe spent two seasons adapting her hit 1976 novel of the same name, so having wrapped up that narrative, it's on to its 1985 sequel.

Second, there's a new point of view. *Interview* was told from the perspective of New Orleans brothel-owner-turned-vampire Louis de Pointe du Lac (the tremendous Jacob Anderson), as he recounted his twisted romances with narcissistic maker Lestat de Lioncourt (Sam Reid) and deceptive rebound Armand (Assad Zaman) to journalist Daniel Molloy (Eric Bogosian). Now it's time for Lestat (and the wildly gifted Reid) to take

center stage, and what better way than to invite Molloy — now a vampire himself and whose Louis-centric book, *Interview With the Vampire*, has become a bestseller that Lestat contests — to film a documentary about *his* life while touring as the Gothic-glam, self-confessed vampire frontman of a rock band?

"He's got a microphone in his hand and I think there's just something chemically that goes off [in him] that says, 'I'm going to approach it with no edit button like I have the rest of my 265 years,'" says showrunner Rolin Jones.

And finally, there's a seismic shift in tone. In addition to showcasing several original songs per episode by the show's composer Daniel Hart, an edgier grit ("It should just smell like CBGB's bathroom," jokes Jones) has been deftly injected into the show.

So strap in for a gutsy, gory and at times surrealistic update to Rice's tome that smartly takes bites from Lestat's 18th century France backstory. — *Damian Holbrook*

## 10 UFC RIVALS

"I have been a fan of the sport since its inception in the early '90s. I grew up wrestling," Mario Lopez says. "UFC was the first time I saw an avenue that wrestlers could pursue, to use their skill sets and make some real money. Now wrestling is the strongest background for all the champions and the one they credit the most. I was fascinated with UFC from the beginning."

That makes the *Saved by the Bell* and *Access Hollywood* star the perfect person to host this two-part, in-depth look at some of the most iconic feuds in Ultimate Fighting Championship history, from Chuck Liddell vs. Tito Ortiz to Georges St-Pierre vs. Matt Serra. Lopez leads a roundtable of experts in discussions about these rivalries, and how each defined an era and helped transform the UFC into the global phenomenon it is today.

## 9 ALL AMERICAN: THE FINAL SEASON SPECIAL

Monday, June 22 on THE CW

Fans have to wait until July 13 for the eighth and final season of the beloved drama to premiere, but The CW is getting the party started early with an hourlong *All American* retrospective special chronicling the journey of the characters both on and off the football field. The tribute looks back at the show's most memorable moments, relationships and milestones, and honors the legacy of a series that has resonated with audiences and redefined the modern sports drama. The final season picks up six months after the Season 7 cliffhanger and spans just one pivotal week in the lives of the Beverly and Crenshaw crew.

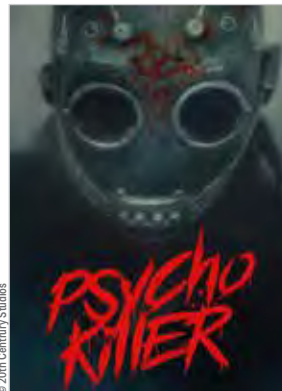
