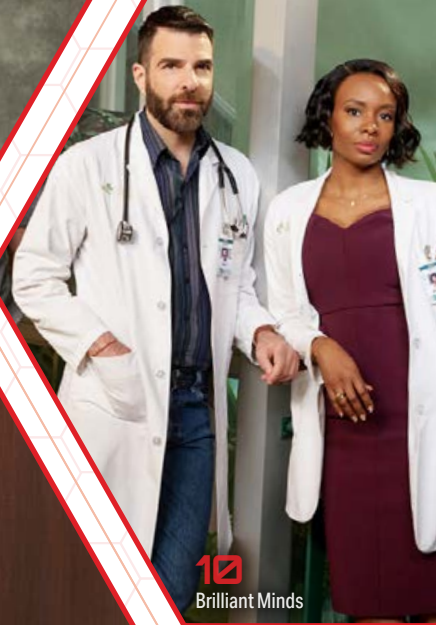

- **Who's In It?** Reba McEntire, Melissa Peterman, Belissa Escobedo, Pablo Castelblanco, Rex Linn
- **What's It All About?** Reba McEntire stars as Bobbie, a widow who inherits her father's bar and discovers that she has to share it with Isabella (Belissa Escobedo), the half sister she didn't know she had. "Bobbie's a pretty intense character," McEntire says. "She's very devoted to the tavern and to her dad's memory, and she wants everything to stay as it is." Meanwhile, Isabella has plans for big changes at the bar, which causes friction with Bobbie. Melissa Peterman, McEntire's costar on *Reba* (2001-07), reunites onscreen with her real-life pal. Peterman plays Gabby, a longtime bartender at Happy's Place. Rex Linn, McEntire's partner since 2020, plays cook Emmett. So the cast won't have to work hard to create a feel-good family atmosphere on *Happy's Place*. — Ryan A. Berenz

- **What's It All About?** A gay English teacher (Brian Jordan Alvarez) in Austin, Texas, tries to balance the personal, political and professional aspects of his life working among modern teenagers in the South and their demanding parents. "The show lives on the edge and we have fun there," says Alvarez, who is also the creator, director and executive producer of the witty and bold new series. "We play in that gray area very specifically. And if we get in the editing room and it feels over the edge, then you just don't put that into the show." Adds fellow executive producer Paul Simms: "A lot of what the show is about also is the characters themselves within the show talking about what are we allowed to say anymore and what's right and what's wrong these days."



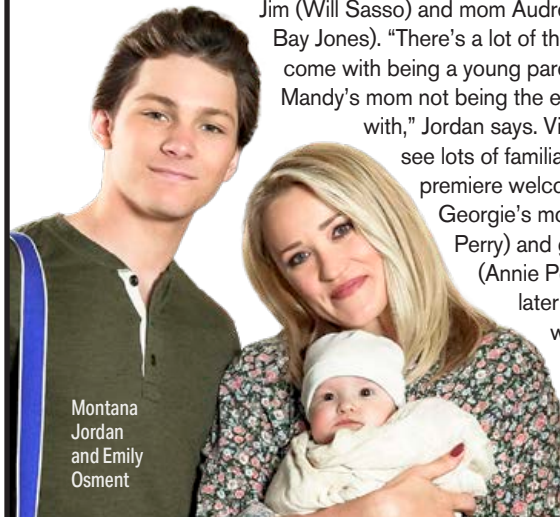

Says executive producer Dave King on the selection of literature referenced and taught to students: "We tried to make the books that they were reading thematically relevant. They often ended up being kind of surface-level relevant because we also needed the audience to get it very quickly. That's how executive producer Chuck Lorre describes the domestic life of Georgie Cooper (Montana Jordan) and his 31-year-old bride, Mandy (Emily Osment), the main characters of this *Young Sheldon* sequel series. The comedy finds the new parents trying to coexist with Mandy's dad

Jim (Will Sasso) and mom Audrey (Rachel Bay Jones). "There's a lot of things that come with being a young parent and with Mandy's mom not being the easiest to deal with," Jordan says. Viewers will see lots of familiar faces: The premiere welcomes back Georgie's mother (Zoe Perry) and grandmother (Annie Potts), and later episodes will include Georgie's sister Missy (Raegan Revord). — Meaghan Darwish

- **What's It All About?** The famous father-son comedy duo reunites for this multicamera family sitcom. Damon Wayans plays Poppa, an O.G. who hosts the *Poppa's House* radio show in New York City. His world gets rocked when the station hires Dr. Ivy Reed (Essence Atkins) to be his cohost. Her modern, sophisticated and female perspective creates an instant rivalry with Poppa. Meanwhile, Poppa's still trying to mentor his son, Junior (Damon Wayans Jr.), a married father of two, who works as a salesman at his father-in-law's company while he pursues his dream of directing movies. — *Ryan A. Berenz*

St. Denis Medical

- **Premieres:** Nov. 12
- **Airs:** Tuesdays at 8pm
- **Who's In It?** Wendi McLendon-Covey, Josh Lawson, David Alan Grier, Allison Tolman
- **What's It All About?** This mockumentary-style comedy series executive produced by *Superstore*'s Justin Spitzer follows an underfunded and understaffed hospital in Oregon where medical staff must balance treating patients with maintaining their own sanity. "The fun of it is we get to play these folks who are reattaching arms but then also just, like, have to eat," says *Fargo*'s Allison Tolman, who plays a nurse named Alex.

"For anyone who works anywhere, after enough time, a job is just a job like any other," adds executive producer Eric Ledgin. "Except that this happens to be in the highest-stakes place possible. So, we really are trying to find a balance between moments that are funny and moments that are sincere; we don't shy away from those moments when the story calls for it."

- **What's It All About?** New Jersey brothers Adam and Craig Malamut have several sports-themed animated comedies under their belts, and they're the creative forces behind this new addition to FOX's Animation Domination block. In *Universal Basic Guys*, brothers Mark and Hank Hoagies lose their jobs at the Glantontown Hot Dog factory. Fortunately for them, their town has launched a Universal Basic Income program in which each resident receives \$3,000 per month with no strings attached. With free money and tons of free time, the brothers and their buddies are living it up. FOX has already ordered a second season.

Rock, Terry Crews and Tichina Arnold return to voice their characters from the previous series. Tim Johnson Jr. voices young Chris.

- **What's It All About?** This half-hour comedy series from Sam Mendes, Armando Iannucci and Jon Brown follows the crew of an unloved franchise movie and all the chaos that goes on behind the scenes of a superhero film.

- **Where We Left Off:** The Guide (Kristen Schaal) was up to all kinds of mischief, including revealing Guillermo's (Harvey Guillén) secret about his half-transformation to Nandor (Kayvan Novak). Nandor was determined to kill Guillermo, but a talk with Patton Oswalt at Panera Bread quelled his rage. Guillermo decided he wants to be human after all.
- **What To Expect:** The sixth and final season will have 11 episodes, three of which will debut Oct. 21. Guillermo has to reevaluate his life and his role in the house after becoming fully human again. - **What To Expect:** Mary Holland plays Patience in a recurring role. According to CBS, Patience was too strict (even by Puritan standards) and expelled from her village. She died in the late 1600s, and has been roaming the dirt since Isaac abandoned her in the late 1800s. Dean Norris guest-stars as Sam's (Rose McIver) absentee father, Frank. A new ghost at Woodstone forces Sam to confront her feelings about Frank.

- **Where We Left Off:** Janine (Quinta Brunson) and Gregory (Tyler James Williams) kissed at Janine's end-of-school-year party.
- **What To Expect:** "I really want to see how they navigate, how much of their personal life comes into the workspace and vice versa," Williams tells TV Insider of the burgeoning romance. "What's the balance? Because you've always known each other in a professional sense and now you're getting to know each other in a deeper romantic sense." Brunson told the audience at San Diego Comic-Con in July, "We will be doing an interesting crossover this season. I'm not gonna tell you with who or with what or where or when or how. But just know, it's really exciting and I think it will change television as we know it."

High Potential

- ◆ **What's It All About?** It's fitting that one of the most anticipated fall TV shows has a title like *High Potential*. A fish-out-of-water tale with shades of *The Rookie* and *Castle* that stars the deft Kaitlin Olson (*It's Always Sunny in Philadelphia*, *Hacks*), ABC's newest dramedy procedural, written by *Alias* and *The Good Place* vet Drew Goddard, is poised to be a breakout series. And Olson is ready.

"It's so different than anything I've done before," she says, even though her protagonist Morgan Gillory — a single mom of three with a genius IQ — bears some resemblance to *Sunny's* wisecracking barfly "Sweet Dee" Reynolds. "I still love a scrappy character. Morgan's incredibly intelligent, but it tortures her. She also is a wonderful mom who cares so much about her kids. It's a fun departure from the degenerate characters I've played."

Based on the French hit *Haut Potentiel Intellectuel*, this take taps into Olson's crackerjack comedic timing and dramatic abilities as her authority-averse brainiac juggles parenthood with the search for a missing beau and an unlikely alliance with the LAPD. "She's the cleaning lady, and in the first episode, as she's dancing around cleaning in the middle of the night, she knocks over a big pile of evidence," Olson explains.

While trying to put everything back in place, Morgan uses her exceptional intelligence to figure out the suspect board on the wall, and *voilà!* She's recruited to help intrigued Lt. 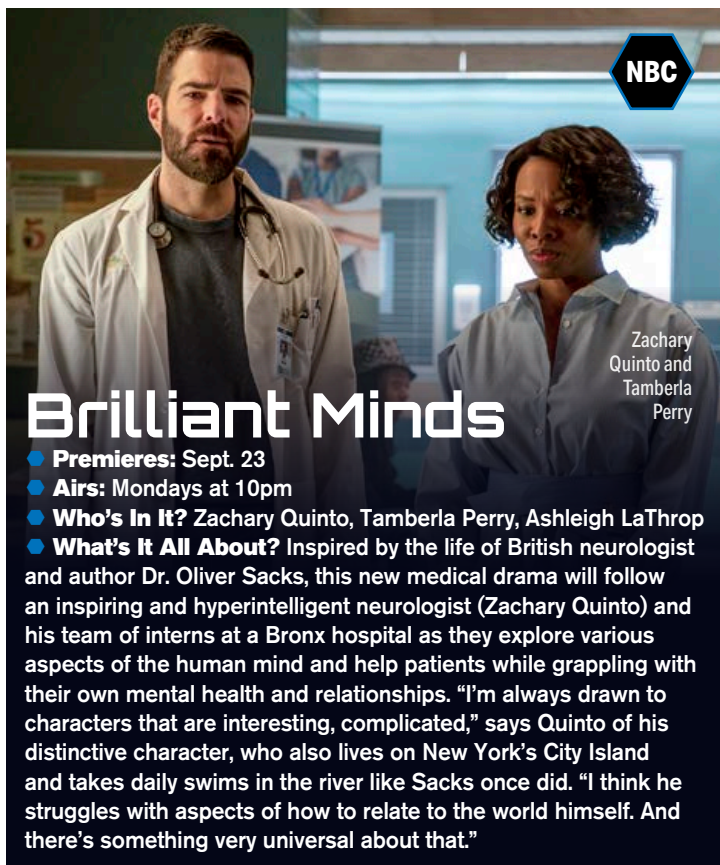

"That was week one of filming, on one of the biggest days we had at Pipeline. That's not CGI. That's me," she says. "Part of the audition process was they asked me, 'Are you ready for this?' And I was like, 'Hell, yeah!' I got here and I was like, 'Oh my God, am I ready?'" The cast trained for three weeks before cameras rolled.

Like the iconic lifeguard hit *Baywatch*, there's plenty of bravery on the show, but *Rescue* focuses less on beauty. Exec producer and writer Matt Kester grew up surfing on the North Shore and based the characters on locals, wanting to show the real people of Hawaii and give a sense of the community they live in. The gripping rescue scenarios are all based on actual events as related to Kester by big wave surfers and lifeguards. And though the cast may get mistaken for guards, they know the show's real star. "Our No. 1 diva is the ocean," Kebbel says. "She changes her mind every second of the day, and the moment you get an ego, it's over." — *Kate Hahn*

"I think that a lot of people are really enticed by the mystery of something very specific that drove him over the edge," says Josh Rivera, who plays Hernandez. "The reality is that something like that was on its way for a little while. Unfortunately, he really wasn't well by the time that that happened. So, who's to say?"

Hernandez suffered through an abusive childhood, the sudden death of his father while he was a teenager and what was posthumously deemed the worst case of CTE (the brain disease chronic traumatic encephalopathy) to date, all before the age of 27 — all of which likely factored into his mental decline. "There's a very obvious low-hanging-fruit archetype there, which is 'big dude, professional football player, murderer. I know who this guy is.' You don't," Rivera adds. "We all have a very rich inner life, and I would hope that it kind of challenges our tendency to stereotype based on the little that we know. My favorite point that we make, that I hope everybody takes away, is that a person isn't one thing almost ever." — *Zhanna Slor*

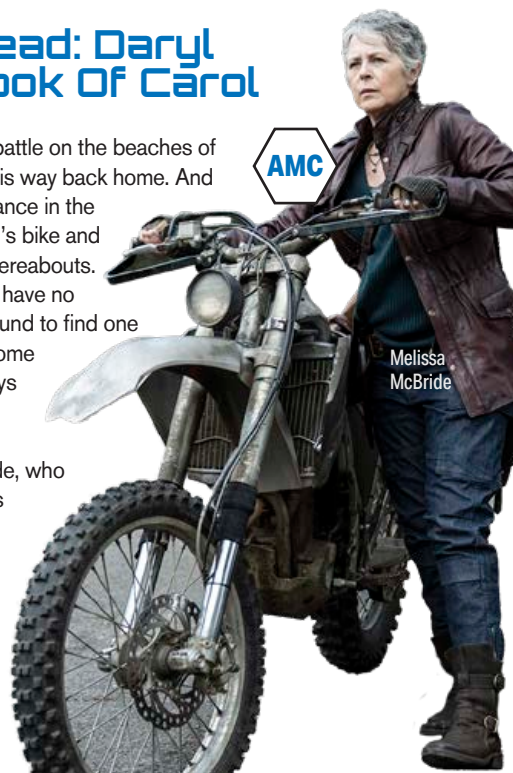

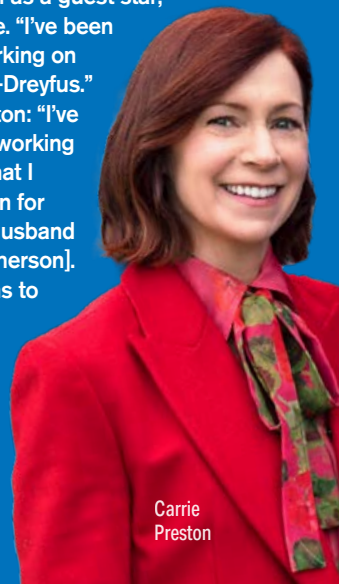

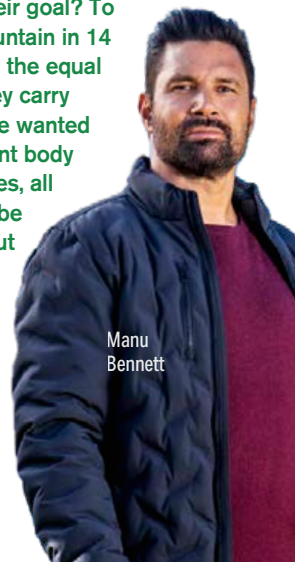
