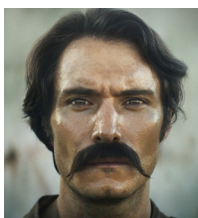
Squid Game

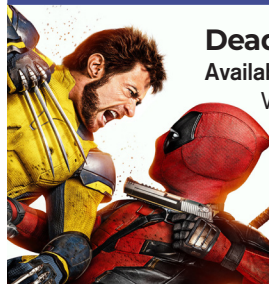

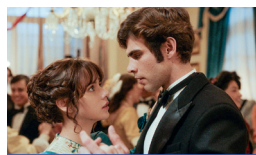

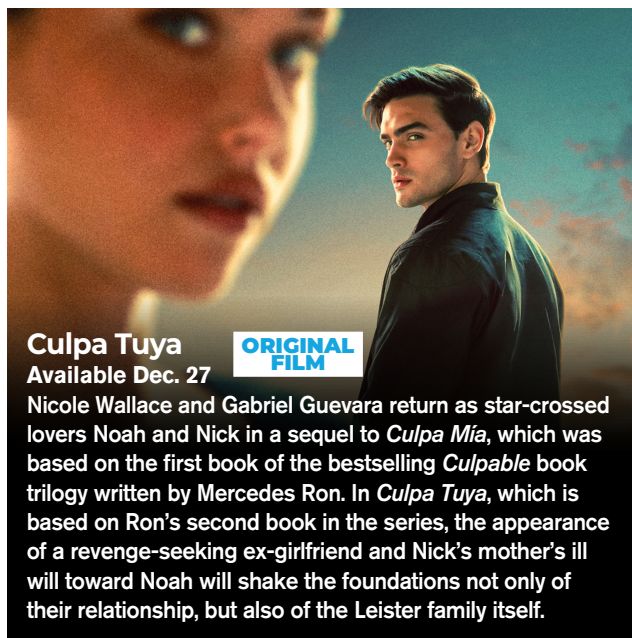
