At the last minute, he decides to bring with them talented striker Vinny (Micheal Ward), who could give them a real chance at winning, but only if he is ready to let go of his past and become part of the team.

The Casagrandes Movie

Giannis: The Marvelous Journey

Available Now

When the Milwaukee Bucks selected Giannis Antetokounmpo in the first round of the 2013 NBA Draft, fans knew little about the teenager from Greece, and he knew almost nothing about life as an NBA rookie in the States. Antetokounmpo recalls how he was going to bring his workout clothes

home to wash when he was told he could leave them at the practice facility. "I can wash the clothes here?" he asked. "No, Giannis, we wash the clothes here," it was explained. "I said, 'You wash the clothes for me?'" They said, "Yes, you come tomorrow, the clothes will be washed." I said, "Oh, OK. I love the NBA!" There's also the time in November 2013 when fans recognized him as he was running to the arena (he didn't have cab fare) and offered him a car ride. "It was a funny story," Antetokounmpo tells us in an interview. "I am thankful to this day that they were able to give me a ride so I wasn't late to the game. I think they saved me from pneumonia. It was extremely cold. It was probably one of the worst winters Milwaukee had." More than 10 years later, the "Greek Freak" is a two-time MVP, an NBA champion and a father of three. This feature-length documentary looks at Antetokounmpo, his family, his basketball career, and how he overcame poverty and xenophobia to become a global superstar. — *Ryan A. Berenz*

"Everybody has a chance to score," says an awestruck Carol Burnett of working among a heavy-hitting cast of scene-stealers — the famous faces include Kristen Wiig, Allison Janney, Ricky Martin and Laura Dern — in this raucous series about life at a swanky

Palm Beach, Florida, country club in 1969. However, the icon could also be talking about the many ambitious (and duplicitous) characters that populate the show. The 10 episodes begin with Wiig's penniless Maxine Simmons, who will cross any line to become a part of the Palm Beach elite. She sneaks into the Palm Royale, where she meets snooty Evelyn Rollins (Janney), the de facto ruler of the club's wealthy lady clique.

The real queen bee is Burnett's Norma Dellacorte. "Most of the people in that society, they're afraid of her because she has a lot of secrets on them," the six-time Emmy winner explains. "She's not a very nice person." — *Jim Halterman*

The Girls on the Bus

Available Thursdays Beginning March 14

This 10-episode dramedy chronicles the fast-paced, messy and often hilarious lives of fictional female journalists reporting on the Democratic primary. "It's about the kind of friendship that you never knew you needed but you can't live without," says cocreator Amy Chozick, whose career as a political journo covering prominent figures like Hillary Clinton, Kamala Harris and Elizabeth Warren inspired the series. *Supergirl*'s Melissa Benoist stars as idealistic reporter Sadie McCarthy. "She's an old soul," Chozick explains. "She romanticizes an era of journalism that kind of doesn't exist anymore ... when you could write in your own voice and have a huge impact."

The show's politicians are amalgams of candidates Chozick met on the road, as are the journalists who round out the cast: "old-school, get-the-scoop-out" veteran Grace (Carla Gugino); conservative Fox Newsesque reporter Kimberlyn (Christina Elmore); and young social media influencer Lola (Natasha Behnam). The women don't have much in common, but they become close. — *Dylan Ford*
