Follow Queen Charlotte's (Golda Rosheuvel) rise to power in this six-episode prequel to Shonda Rhimes' popular historical drama *Bridgerton*. It tells the story of how the young queen's (India Amarteifio plays the regent in her younger years) marriage to King George (Corey Mylchreest) sparked both a great love story and a societal shift, creating the world of the Ton inherited by the characters in *Bridgerton*. Rhimes serves as creator, showrunner, writer and executive producer here.

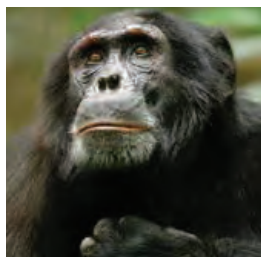

Eurovision Song Contest 2023

Set to take place in Liverpool, England, after last year's winner, Ukraine, became unable to host due to the Russian invasion, the 67th edition of the Eurovision Song Contest begins on May 9 with its first round of semifinals airing live on Peacock as well as the Eurovision YouTube channel. The second round of semifinals will air on May 11, and the contest will conclude on May 13 with its final round and winner selection. Thirty-seven countries will participate, with Bulgaria, Montenegro and North Macedonia ceasing to be included this year.
